Ratio: A qualified employer shall employ one (1) apprentice when three (3) journeymen are regularly employed, and one (1) additional apprentice for each three (3) additional journeymen. An employer may employ one (1) apprentice when a project calls for fewer than three (3) journeymen.

Geographical Coverage: Northern 46 Counties of California excluding San Joaquin, Tuolumne, and Yolo Counties.

Apprentices shall be paid wages and fringes pursuant to the appropriate provisions contained in the collective bargaining agreement and as registered with the California Division of Apprenticeship Standards and the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Apprenticeship.
