Ratio: A qualified employer shall employ one (1) apprentice when three (3) journeymen are regularly employed, and one (1) additional apprentice for each three (3) additional journeymen. An employer may employ one (1) apprentice when a project calls for fewer than three (3) journeymen.

Work Day: Eight (8) consecutive hours (exclusive of meal period), shall constitute a day's work for straight-time rates. One and one-half (1 ½) times the regular straight time hourly rate shall be paid for all work on Saturdays (except make-up day) and before a shift begins and after it ends. Double the regular straight time hourly rate shall be paid for all work on Sundays and holidays.

Apprentices shall be paid wages and fringes pursuant to the appropriate provisions contained in the local collective bargaining agreement and as registered with the California Division of Apprenticeship Standards and the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Apprenticeship.
