Ratio: Employers shall participate in the Plaster Tender Apprenticeship Program by accepting apprentices for employment upon referral by the Union. The Employer shall employ one (1) apprentice after three (3) journey-level Plaster Tenders on a project. On projects with fewer than three (3) journey-level Plaster Tenders, an employer may employ one (1) apprentice per project with at least one (1) journey-level Plaster Tender.

Geographic Coverage: Alameda, Contra Costa

Apprentices shall be paid wages and fringes pursuant to the appropriate provisions contained in the local collective bargaining agreement and as registered with the California Division of Apprenticeship Standards and the U.S. Department of Labor, Office of Apprenticeship.
